

Proceedings of Ordinary Gram Sabha Meeting held on 16/08/2015 at 11.00 am in the Panchayat hall, Buticas Navelim under the chairmanship of Sarpanch Shri. Frank Fernandes.

The signatures of the members present are taken on the attendance register where in 65 members remained present. Earlier the meeting is adjourned half an hour after waiting for 15 minutes and the same started at 11.45 am.

At the outset the Sarpanch Shri. Frank Fernandes welcomed the members present and informed that a sizeable information is updated on the website vpsavelim.com and called upon them to make the best use of the same and suggest ways to improve it. He further expressed his satisfaction over the period of time the website is updated and thanked the staff for their efforts in completing the work in shortest time. He further called upon the members to cooperate to conduct the meeting in peaceful atmosphere.

1) To read and confirm the proceedings of previous meeting:-

Proceedings of the previous Gram Sabha Meeting dt 31/05/2015 are read and unanimously confirmed.

Also the Action Taken report in respect to Gram Sabha Meeting is read out for information of members. The members while confirming the report suggested as under:-

- 1) Shri. Eleuterio suggested to review the decision to purchase power tiller by panchayat since power tiller is not available with ZAO. Also advise could be sought from ZAO before purchase of the said tiller.
- 2) Shri. Luis Rodrigues spoke on tenants verification and early finalization of the same.
- 3) Shri. Cruz Rodrigues sought to know about the garbage plants established by the Govt in North & South Goa and finalization of proper place for disposal of garbage.

The members present emphasized the need for soak pits to the said families and further reiterated their resolve to provide such pits to each and every SC/ST family.

4) To Consider proposals / suggestions received from gram sabha members

2) Proposals of Anastasio Eleuterio Carneiro

The proposal received from Anastasio Eleuterio Carneiro are placed before the members and decided as under:

- 1) W.r.t proposal 1, it is suggested that the Panchayat Members should provide name of tenant and also charge one month rent and involve students in tackling garbage menace. He further stressed that tenants have been a nuisance and strict action should be initiated so that the disposal of garbage is streamlined.
- 2) The Market fees collection is discussed in respect to proposal 2 and it is confirmed that there is no term as Sopo. In the Panchayat Act or Rules, However the Sarpanch informed that the panchayat is in the process of finalising the rates and which are finalised, the panchayat has implemented. It is further suggested that Agriculture produced in the Village should not be charged. He also suggested declaration of Market Area. Shri. Siddharth Karapurkar shared similar views on establishing of market area.
- 3) W.r.t proposal 3, it is unanimously resolved that the Govt. Should scrap the present procedure followed in approval of plans and adhere to old procedure of approval. i.e receipt of application by the Panchayat and after due recommendation approved by the TCPD. Shri. Eleuterio Carneiro Deliberated and suggested that if any plans are approved as per Regional Plan 2021. The same should be stopped and license revoked as the same is denotified. Shri. Joao Mergulhao suggested to verify the jurisdiction of construction being undertaken at foot of the hills at Moddi and hold a joint site inspection with TCPD, as the said area is eco-sensitive.
- 4) W.r.t proposal 4, Shri. Eleuterio Carneiro suggested that subsidised solar energy to be made available to the households by the Govt. which is unanimously adopted. The same is seconded by Harold Pinto.
- 5) W.r.t proposal 5, Shri. Eleuterio Carneiro suggested for identifying agricultural land for cattle grazing ground, since a lot of land in the Navelim Village is not cultivated.
- 6) W.r.t proposal 6 of Shri. Eleuterio Carneiro, it is unanimously resolved to request the Govt that the set back from NH 17 should be 23 meters from Centerline as existed earlier, since the land in Goa is scarce and the land owners can no longer sacrifice their land for road set back. The same is proposed by Anastasio Eleuterio Carneiro and seconded by Siddharth Karapurkar. Shri. Harold Pinto participating suggested one time development planning.
- 7) Proposal 7 & 8 were not proposed for discussion by Eleuterio Carneiro as the same are discussed earlier.

- 8) W.r.t proposal 9, of Shri. Eleuterio Carneiro, it is unanimously resolved to request the Government to open an agriculture college and share the knowledge generated there on with the farmers for promotion of agriculture. The same is seconded by Harold Pinto.
- 9) W.r.t proposal 10 of Shri. Eleuterio Carneiro, it is unanimously resolved to prepare a list of open spaces gifted to the Panchayat. It is further resolved to keep a track of the open spaces existing in the Village.

5) **Any other matter with the permission of the chairman**

- 1) Smt. Celly Quadros informed that garbage is accumulated behind the panchayat and objected to comments of one of the panchayat members that the panchayat area has turned into a sonsddo. The Sarpanch informed the members that efforts are made to clear the garbage on a weekly basis. Shri. Joao Mergulhao advised the panchayat to be alert as agency appointed by pollution control board is not taking all the waste collected by the panchayat but only the plastics & Recyclable waste which he has observed in Velim Panchayat.
- 2) Shri. Joao Mergulhao sought to know the status of Boundary dispute between Navelim & Dramapur village and sought its early solution.
- 3) Shri. A F G Mascarenhas suggested to cover the ceiling of the 2nd floor with GI sheets so as to avoid leakage and weakening of the structure. It is confirmed that repairs are being taken so as to stop the leakages.
- 4) Smt. Celly Quoadros sought to draw the attention of the Gram Sabha Members in respect to thin attendance of panchayat members and called for improvement with greater responsibility.
- 5) Shri. Harold Pinto informed the Gram Sabha members that the Vegetable supplied by Horticulture department are of low quality and hence necessary quality control check needs to be exercised. He also informed that the department should provide sufficient time to the vendors to check the condition of the vegetables supplied atleast till evening and return the same thereupon if it is stale / rotten. It is also requested that the vendors should not be allowed to sell vegetables procured from open market if the same are being supplied by the department so as to avoid over charging and malpractices. After discussion the same is unanimously adopted. The same is seconded by Eleuterio Carneiro.
- 6) Shri. Siddharth Karapurkar sought to know the action proposed by the panchayat in respect to New Education Policy. The Sarpanch informed that he had attended the training with other members as desired and also has fixed meeting on 24/08/2015 at 10.30 am for discussion & uploading suggestion on 27/08/2015 at 10.30 am. He also

requested the concerned or any other gram sabha member having interest to attend the said meetings and put forth their views.

As there being no other matter the meeting ended at 1.45 pm with a vote of thanks.
