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Proceedings of the meeting of v.p. Ordinary Gram sabha meeting of v.p Navelim held on 30/10/2022 at 10:00 AM in the Panchayat Hall. This meeting is presided over by the secretary Mr Paul Pereira.

The signatures of Gram sabha members present are taken on attendance register.

Earlier the meeting is adjourned for half an hour after waiting 15 minutes from the appointed time due to lack of quorum and same started at 10:45 AM.

Res No: 1 To read and confirm the proceedings of the last meeting.

Proceedings of the last meeting held on - 10/09/2022 are read out by the secretary and after going through it in detail it is proposed by Jose Jose Maghalea seconded by Ektavia Caracho and passed unanimously to confirmed.

Res No: 2 To approve supplementary budget

The supplementary budget for the financial year 2022-23 regarding to revise the estimate for maintenance/repairing of Rs 100000. (Rupees ten lakh) of Panchayat Ghar for Rs 100000. (Rupees ten lakh) placed before the meeting. After discussion it is proposed by Selly Quaresma seconded by Jose Soares and passed unanimously to revise the supplementary budget for the financial year 2022-23. Member Mr Harold Pinto suggested to keep Rs three lakh provision for keep two lakh budget provision for burial of stray dogs & cattle and Pound.

Res NO: 7: To discuss the proposal/suggestions received from the Gram Sabha members

7(1) The following proposals received from the Gram Sabha members placed before the meeting and decided in each case as under

7(1) With reference to the proposal received from the Gram Sabha member Shri Joao Jose Magalhaes the following are taken up point wise wise

- A) Resolution to upgradation of Veterinary Services for Navelim to a full fledged hospital.



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The Gram Sabha of Village Navelim discussed that there is no Veterinary hospital in Navelim village due to which the residents who domesticate pets has to face lot of difficulty to take their pets to a Veterinary hospital. It is also discussed that many animals get injured in road mishaps who are left injured and in pain due to non availability of Veterinary hospital. After discussion the Gram Sabha unanimously resolved to forward proposal to the Director of Animal Husbandry Panaji to take up the said proposal with the Govt.

~~B)~~ ~~It is unanimously decided~~ House to house survey for listing listing of tenants

It is unanimously decided to send a resolution to the Public works Dept. (PHE) Electricity Dept and Police Dept to do the tenant verification in all the wards of V.P. Navelim

c) Resolution for Ummed centre for senior citizens under Dept. of social welfare

Gram Sabha member Mr Joao Sousa Margulhao informed the Gram Sabha that there is no centre for senior citizens to spend their leisure time and that having a Ummed centre will be very essential for the senior citizens as they could come to the Ummed centre and have some talk, relieve their stress, read some magazines etc. This could encourage the senior citizens to meet continuously if dedicated Ummed centre is available. He also informed that the matter was also discussed in earlier sessions of the previous Gram Sabha and so atleast now the same should be followed up. After discussion the Gram Sabha unanimously resolved to forward the resolution to social welfare Dept to set up an Ummed centre in Navelim village for senior citizens at the earliest.



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D) Resolution to write to water resource dept. to carry study of ground water, identify wells which are not fit for human consumption. Gram-Sabha member, Mr. Joao Souza, Meigulhas informed the Gram-Sabha that there is need to get the ground water checked whether it is fit for consumption which may have got affected due to various factors which are required to be identified to avoid further contamination and by taking appropriate actions against the violators. The Gram-Sabha anticipated that if the same is not taken up then it may lead to various sickness among the people. After discussion the Gram-Sabha unanimously resolved to forward the proposal to water resource dept. to conduct the verification of the ground water quality in the jurisdiction of Navelim Village.

E) Mr. Joao Meigulhas brought to the notice of the meeting that the work of the sewerage pipeline is incomplete under construction, as a result the road roads remained blocked with slow moving traffic throughout the day. Therefore he proposed to send a letter to the Sewerage Dept./PWD to expedite the work of commissioning of sewerage network in the jurisdiction of Navelim. It is also decided to write to the sewerage dept. that the work of construction of manhole is of substandard quality hence inquiry to be conducted for execution of substandard work by the contractor.

F) It is unanimously decided to shift the traffic signal near the old Post Office junction. It is also

G) It is unanimously decided to shift the roadside vendors in the renovated market or to find to rehabilitate them in the renovated market. He also suggested to constitute street vendors welfare committee.



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H) Mr Joao Megulhao requested the Sarpach to look into the matter of proposal of flyover at Bellem - Navelim Junction of the bylan road as discussed in the previous Gram Sabha and requested that a flyover alignment must be taken up in consultation with the experts as the absence of flyover at the said location is causing lot of inconvenience to the traffic and also the road is become risky. After discussion the Gram Sabha members unanimously ~~was~~ resolved to write to PWD (NH) for alignment of flyover at Bellem junction.

I) Resolution for Rumblers at all road intersections, Mandoga, Buticas II & III

Mr Joao Souza Megulhao request of the Sarpach to install rumblers at the intersection road in Navelim jurisdiction especially at intersection on ~~Navelim~~ National Highway Mandoga Road, Buticas II, Buticas III as the said locations are become accident prone due to overspeeding of vehicles and may cause loss of life. After discussion the Gram Sabha unanimously resolved to forward the proposal to By collector, collector of South Margao to do the needful in the matter.

J) Resolution to withdraw the public lighting cess. Mr Joao Souza Megulhao brought to the notice of the Gram Sabha that the electricity dept. is collecting lighting cess in the electricity Bill to the consumers which was not reflecting in the bills previously. He proposed that the same should be withdrawn as it is an extra burden on the public. After discussion the Gram. Sabha unanimously resolved to forward the proposal to the electricity dept. to consider the proposal and take up the same with the Govt. to withdraw the lighting cess from the electricity bills.

7(2) Proposal received from Sany Gomes regarding scrapping of the Mega Project at Esdi Moddi Mandaps in S/S No 36/0 placed before the meeting. While discussing the matter Sany brought to the notice of the meeting that till date this Panchayat has not received any Mega housing project in the said Sany number. After discussing the matter in detail it is decided that Panchayat should not give any permission for Mega housing project until & unless all the tenants are settled by the owner of the property. Mr Harold Pinto proposed to send a letter to the owner of the property regarding status of the property and Panchayat also should inspect the site to hear the grievances of the Mr Sany Gomes.

7(3) Res No: 7(3) Proposal received from Mr Anastasio Aleutario Carneiro placed before the meeting and decided pointwise as under

A) With regard to wild life (Protection) Act and forest (conservation) Act 1980 in respect to hill cutting and illegal construction of houses at Mandaps - Modi hill by causing environmental damage to the Bio-diversity of the Mandaps - Modi hill. It is unanimously decided to write to the concerned authorities i.e. Forest / Wild life Biodiversity board F&T Town & county Planning dept and Panchayat to conduct joint site inspection and come to a conclusion & to take necessary action

B) With regard to ongoing sewage connection network underground pipeline. It is unanimously decided to write to the sewage department that



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The department to make a proper study reports before execution of work such as project report, work order, type of material to be used and the present capacity of the sewage treatment plant functional at sinvadem and its carrying capacity for new connection for the villages Town of Navelim, Telaulim, Mazao, Feudo, Agrem, Baixo, Davalim, Rais and Candolim

also the engineer and contractors to fix meeting with the stakeholder. Mr Eleteio Carneiro also brought to the notice of the meeting that the Mandoga spring is blocked while executing the sewerage work.

c) with regard to the incident of assault on the Mr Anatrijo Eleteio Carneiro (VDE Convenor) Garbage management committee convenor on 11/18/2022 in connection to dumping of Garbage in the Mandoga River it is unanimously decided to write to the Police Dept. to inquire the matter & to take necessary action

d) with regard to proposal regarding Mobile Tower erected on the divide on NH 66 at Bellom discussed in the meeting while taking part in the discussion Gram-Sabha Member Mr Anatrijo Eleteio Carneiro brought to the notice of the meeting that the said tower is haphazardly erected at Bellom Calvadota opposite dream's skyline complex Navelim without proper setback from the road and blocks the clear view of vehicles traffic. After discussion it is proposed by Eleteio Carneiro seconded by Sebastian Mones and passed unanimously to send a letter to the PWD authorities to immediately dismantle the said tower and shift it to some isolated place on the following grounds.

a) That the said tower is violating the PWD Rule. This 30mtr tower is erected by laying RCC foundation without keeping mandatory setback as per the TCR Act b) Besides the tower either side of the tower on the ground electric circuit are erected. The said boxes obstructing the clear view of the vehicle traffic

c) At violation clause 3 of bylaws issued by the office of the Executive Engineer w.v.v. vide no. PWD/WDV/ASW/A40/235/2022-23 dt 02/8/22 it violates clause 9.5 of the 609 Telecommunication Policy 2020 to erect tower by PWD e) The Gram-Sabha requested the Mandal officer (w.v.v.) as per clause 2 of 609 Telecommunication Policy 2022 to serve notice immediately to the tower to be shifted to alter the tower location from the road divider for the safety of the Public (vehicle traffic) It is also decided to send the said resolution to the Govt of Goa through the Secretary, Panchayat





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e) with regard to the scheduled castes and scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act 1989 against persons for discharging sewage water and disposing garbage into Mandate Tributary of River Sal the corrupting or fouls the water of the said river sal tributary which was ordinary used by members of the scheduled castes or a scheduled tribes to cultivate horticulture crops so as to render it less fit for the purpose for which it is ordinary used. After discussion it is unanimously decided to write the ST commission to take necessary action in the matter.

f) with regard to impose and collect "USER FEE" as per solid waste management rules 2016 with all the residents residing or doing various trading businesses or rendering various services in the jurisdiction of V.P. Navelim it is unanimously decided that Panchayat should take steps to implement the order of the high court & should start collecting wet as well as dry garbage from doorsteps ~~also~~ and also to implement latest amendment to solid waste management rules 2020.

g) with regard to CCTV cameras it is unanimously decided to install CCTV cameras at all the Black spots where miscreants dump garbage at day and night time and to take strict action against the culprits for littering in open places.

7(4) Proposal received from Benito Dasilva placed before the meeting and decided/discussed point wise as under

A) Proposal regarding Directorate of Telecommunication single window clearance for Mobile Tower to be scrapped is unanimously decided to send the Proposal to the Govt of Goa

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F) with regard to CCTV in Navelim and around Navelim main junction it is unanimously decided to install CCTV immediately at four road junction and other places in the jurisdiction of VP Navelim

G) with regard to lighting cess charged by the electricity dept @ 0-05% per unit it is unanimously decided to send a resolution to the electricity dept. to drop the same immediately

H) with regard to IIT Sarguem, it is unanimously decided to send the proposal to the Govt that the Gram Sabha of VP Navelim strongly oppose to setup IIT in Sarguem.

7(s) Proposal received from Herald. Pinto placed before the Gram Sabha and decided pointwise as under

A) with regard to budget allocation for Garbage collection/disposal Sarpanch informed Mr Herald Pinto that the budget provision has been made for Transportation collection of door to door garbage, segregation bailing, making blocks, cleaning of black spots, cleaning of roadside Garbage, cleaning of western bypass Garbage, Disposal of Dry/Wet Garbage, sweeping footpath/street & cleaning of Market etc.

B) Herald Pinto informed the Gram Sabha that there are many accidents happening along the new western bypass that the said bypass is become prone to anti social elements of which cases are rising day by day which needs to be addressed at the earliest. He sought from the Sarpanch whether any action in this regard is taken by the Panchayat. The Sarpanch proposed to forward the said proposal to the Police to look into the matter. The resolution is passed unanimously by the Gram Sabha.



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c) with regard to maintain open defecation free status. Mr Harold Pinto stated that Panchayat should ~~control~~ controlled open defecation. he further stated that Panchayat should construct public toilets. Sanyach suggested to take up the matter before the Village Development Committee for taking necessary proposal for construction of ~~Public~~ Public Toilets.

Mr Harold Pinto brought to the notice of the Gram-Sabha that the Panchayat has allotted duplicate house numbers to many houses. he further stated that Panchayat should rectify the error to which Sanyach replied that hearing will be given to both the parties case to case wise and necessary decision will be taken by the Panchayat.

E) It is proposed by Mr Harold Pinto to send a letter to the ~~Chief~~ Director of information and publicity & not to give advertisement on Cable TV network as the subscribers are paying money to the cable operators.

f) regarding Gram-sabha notice not put on in the Panchayat website. Sanyach informed the Gram-Sabha that henceforth the notice of Gram-sabha will be uploaded on Panchayat website.

g) with regard to Mr Harold Pinto asked the Sanyach whether permission has been given to Gades in front of the Panchayat to which Sanyach informed the Gram-Sabha that the Panchayat has not issued any permission to the said Gade. Mr Simon Fernandes also brought to the notice of the Gram-Sabha that ~~there are~~ Gades have been installed opposite Fradilem chapel. he further stated that the said Gades should be removed immediately to which Sanyach replied that the Gades will be removed after conducting site inspection along with the concerned ward member.


