Res No: 1 To read and confirm the proceedings of the last meeting

done lot of works under Biodiversity Management Act and also for garbage waste management in the village. Mr. Eleteiro Carneiro while giving reply to his resignation letter brought to the notice of the Gram-Sabha that Biodiversity Management committee does not have power to take action. He further stated that the Panchayat should send a letter to the Goa State Biodiversity to amend the act in respect to punishment to those who violate the act thereby causing damage to the Biodiversity, the said power should be given to the Village Biodiversity committee. The Biodiversity Management Act is beneficial to international companies. called Mr.

Mrs. Celcy Quadros informed the Gram-Sabha that objection have been already filed to the Goa State Biodiversity Management Board by the Navelim Biodiversity Management Committee.

After discussing the matter in detail, it is proposed by Indira Vay seconded by Mr. Joao Magalhães to appoint/select Mr. Mellwyn Pereira as the member of Navelim Biodiversity Management committee in place of Anastacio Eleteiro Carneiro. This resolution is unanimously approved by the Gram-Sabha.

Res No. 3: To discuss the Goa Model Panchayat solid waste (Management and Handling) Bye-laws.

Secretary read out the notification published in the official gazette dated 9th February 2022 with regard to the user charges to be collected by the Panchayat for providing service of door to door collection of solid waste under the Goa Model Panchayat solid waste (Management and Handling) Bye-laws.

After going through it in detail it is proposed by Mr. Joao Magalhães to collect 50/- Rs per month from the individual/Indi individual households instead of 75/- Rs per month and Panchayat should take

<p>collect the dry garbage on weekly once a week and take necessary steps to collect wet garbage. with regard to of commercial and other user charges it is proposed to collect as per the notification: Mr Inacio Vaz stated proposed to collect the user fee from well even from un-assessed houses and Hawkers and business operating without trade licences and this shall serve only as a service charge toward collection of waste and shall not confer any legal rights on status to them. Mr Inacio Vaz further proposed that Panchayat should start collect the user charge immediately and also to prepare data with regard to income & expenditure incurred towards the garbage collection and disposal of garbage. Res No. 6: Mr Anthony Alvares brought to the notice of the meeting that the Postal staff communicates in Hindi with locals as some of the locals do not get it difficult to speak in Hindi as a result it causes inconvenience to the general public. Therefore he proposed to send a letter to the Regional incharge of Regional Officer to ~~take~~ ~~necess~~ appoint at least one staff who is ~~conversant~~ conversant in local language that is Konkani in order to communicate with the locals. This resolution is seconded by Inacio Vay and passed unanimously.

Res No. 7: Mr Joao Megulhas brought to the notice of the Gram-Sabha that the department of Town and country planning has recently introduced amendment. The said amendment will have adverse effect on Goa's infrastructure, demography and demography ~~and~~ and will lead to destruction of Goa's green areas. 
